Examples of these types of companies include: Automotive and Mobility companies, Architecture and Engineering Firms, ITS and tier 1 suppliers, and companies providing digital solutions for transportation. Core companies are also defined as any company deriving at least 30% of their total revenue from North American transportation revenue.
