PITTSBURG LAUNCHES NEW PILOT

Partnership to trial free rides for low-income residents | August 17, 2022

The City of Pittsburgh Department of Mobility and Infrastructure (DOMI) has partnered with Carnegie Mellon University, Spin, and others to launch a [Guaranteed Basic Mobility](#) (GBM) pilot program in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Through this year-long program, 50 low-income residents will have free access to [Move PGH](#) transportation services – including Spin scooters, POGO bikes, Zipcar, and public transit. The project, funded by a grant from the Richard King Mellon Foundation and Spin, aims to explore the potential impact that GBM could have on positive health, economic, and social outcomes.

RTA LAUNCHES FLEX PILOT PROGRAM

Pilot for on-demand paratransit service rolls out | August 22, 2022

The New Orleans Regional Transit Authority (RTA), leveraging funding from FTA's 2020 [Mobility for All Pilot Program](#) and the Uber smartphone app designed for this project, has launched the FLEX pilot – a 12-month pilot that will allow East New Orleans paratransit riders to book on-demand trips within Orleans Parish in New Orleans, Louisiana. Project funding was used to purchase three wheelchair lift-equipped vehicles that can be requested in advance, as well as on-demand via app. The pilot aims to improve mobility for individuals with disabilities, seniors, and low-income travelers.
