#### YORK CITY LAUNCHES NEW BIKESHARE

Partnership with Zagster to promote active, healthy commuting in York, PA Launched on June 30, 2017

In partnership with bikesharing company, Zagster, York City has launched a new bikesharing program. As of June 30, bikes are now available for pick up at three bike stations across the city. Residents and visitors can access these bikes either through a \$20 annual Zagster membership or for \$3 an hour (up to \$30 per ride). Members can ride for free for the first two hours of each trip, after which they are charged \$2 per hour. The program is funded through a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Health's Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grant program with the aim of promoting health and physical activity. York City officials hope to expand this program in the future.

#### CITY OF WORCESTER & ZIPCAR PARTNER

Zipcar Worcester to provide carsharing service in Worcester, PA Launched on June 28, 2017

As of June 28, the City of Worcester and Zipcar have partnered to bring carsharing to residents, visitors, and businesses. Through this partnership, six cars are available downtown for reservation by the day or by the hour. Users may drive up to 180 miles per day and reservations include both gas and insurance. Additionally, local businesses are eligible to receive discounted driving rates when using the cars on weekdays. Vehicles can be reserved via Zipcar's mobile app, online, or over the phone, and are parked and picked up at designated spots. Through this program, the city hopes to alleviate the demand for parking by providing an alternative to car ownership.
