DART LAUNCHES NEW PILOT PARTNERSHIP

DART, Lyft, & MV Transportation partner for paratransit service in Dallas, TX Launched on October 25, 2017

Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) has partnered with paratransit service provider, MV Transportation, and rideshare service provider, Lyft, to offer ondemand paratransit service in Dallas, Texas. This pilot supplements MV Transportation's operation of DART's paratransit program, enabling 160 participating paratransit riders to book free Lyft rides for their travel needs. Ride costs are covered under the existing contract between DART and MV Transportation, and the program will be operated on a month-by-month basis. This partnership expands the system's paratransit capacity by 7% and aims help elderly and disabled users access timely rides when needed.

RURAL RIDE-HAILING LAUNCHING IN TEXAS

Partnership to provide rural ride-hailing service in the Coastal Bend Region Launch: November 2017

The Texas Department of Transportation and the Coastal Bend Center for Independent Living have partnered with Liberty Mobility Now (Liberty) to roll out Mobility Now! in the Texas Costal Bend Region. The Mobility Now! project aims to facilitate transportation for vulnerable communities in rural areas. Specifically, this partnership serves to increase transportation options for individuals with disabilities, veterans, the elderly, and low income families in rural Texas by providing access to affordable, 24/7 ride-hailing service. Rides can be reserved via a toll-free call center or smart phone application. Texas is the sixth of seven states to roll out Libery's Mobility NOW! this year.
