CAPITAL METRO AND RIDEAUSTIN PARTNER

Microtransit partnership to connect riders to bus service in west Austin, TX Launched on June 4, 2018 (6 month pilot)

Capital Metro has partnered with Austin-based rideshare service provider, RideAustin, to offer on-demand transportation to select bus stops following cuts to bus service in the Exposition area of west Austin. Through this sixmonth pilot program, individuals who live or work in the area that has lost bus service can request rides via the RideAustin app to/from one of two local Capital Metro bus stops. These rides are free of charge, so those who participate in the program do not have to pay any more than their usual bus fare to complete their commute. Capital Metro hopes that this partnership will help to efficiently fill transit gaps by serving as an innovative, effective solution to first/last mile needs. The pilot will be evaluated upon conclusion.

BLUE ASH LAUNCHES BIKESHARE PROGRAM

Partnership between the City of Blue Ash and Zagster Inc. in Blue Ash, OH Launched on June 13, 2018

The City of Blue Ash has partnered with bikeshare provider, Zagster, to launch the first bikeshare program in a Cincinnati suburb. As of June 13, fifty bikes are available for rent at eight Blue Ash Zagster stations throughout the city – stations are located in downtown Blue Ash, at Summit Park, and in several other heavily trafficked areas. Bikes can be unlocked via the Zagster mobile app and ridden for \$1 per half hour (up to \$20 per ride). Annual and student memberships are also available. At the end of a ride, bikes should be returned to one of the designated stations, but they may be docked briefly at any public bike rack for mid-ride stops. This bikeshare partnership aims to offer the community a fun, affordable, and convenient way to explore the city.
