BIKESHARE RETURNS TO HARRISBURG

SusqueCycle Regional Bikeshare program launches | October 10, 2022

The Tri-County Regional Planning Commission and Tandem Mobility have partnered to launch the [SusqueCycle Regional Bikeshare Program](#), bringing bikeshare back to Harrisburg, Pennsylvania. As of October 10, thirty-six bikes are available for rent at six locations within Harrisburg. Rides can be booked within the Movatic app and cost either \$1.50 per 30min on a pay-as-you-go basis or \$25 annually for unlimited 30min trips with regional membership. SusqueCycle aims to provide a healthy, environmentally-friendly mobility option for residents and visitors to explore the area.

PFLUGERVILLE LAUNCHES RIDESHARE

Partnership for discounted point-to-point rides | October 1, 2022

The City of Pflugerville has teamed up with TRIPPP Consulting, Uber, and Maruti Transportation Group to launch the [Pfetch a Ride](#) program in Pflugerville, Texas. Through this program, as of October 1, travelers can download and use up to ten \$10 vouchers monthly that can be applied to help cover the cost of Uber rides within the designated service area. Travellers must pay for the first \$4 of their ride before using a voucher to save up to \$10 on the remaining fare. Pfetch a Ride also includes Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV) service from Maruti. Rides can be booked via Uber app or by phone.
