

#### MTTA TEAMS UP FOR MICROTRANSIT

Partnership between MTTA, DART, Unwire, & RideCo | April 2, 2023

Metropolitan Tulsa Transit Authority (MTTA), Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART), Unwire, and RideCo have partnered to launch a new microtransit service in Tulsa, Oklahoma. This program aims to improve first/last mile mobility, connect travelers with transportation hubs, and provide additional access to point-to-point travel within the designated service area. By integrating RideCo's on-demand microtransit platform with MTTA's existing GoPass trip planning and payment app delivered by DART through Unwire's mobility platform, riders can now more seamlessly plan dynamic and multimodal trips.

#### **CCTA LAUNCHES AV SHUTTLE SERVICE**

Partnership with Beep for free, electric, driverless rides | April 24, 2023

Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) has partnered with Beep to launch <a href="PRESTO">PRESTO</a> low-speed automated vehicle (AV) service in San Ramon, California. Through this program, driverless electric shuttles that can hold up to eight passengers are now available to transport travelers along a four-stop route, free of charge, in Bishop Ranch business park. The service, which is supported by funding from the Federal Highway Administration's Advanced Transportation and Congestion Management Technologies Deployment (ATCMTD) program is scheduled to operate on weekdays through fall of 2023.
