CITYBUS PARTNERS FOR VANPOOL

Collaborative effort with Commute with Enterprise | October 17, 2023

CityBus has teamed up with Commute with Enterprise to launch CityVan of Greater Lafayette, a new vanpooling service in Tippecanoe County, Indiana. Through this program, Commute with Enterprise can coordinate with and match four or more riders who have similar work schedules and work in similar areas, who are interested in riding together. Anyone traveling to a work site located in Tippecanoe County can potentially use this service. Funding from the Federal Transit Administration will be used to partially subsidize CityVan. Employers and/or participants will cover remaining costs.

GCRTA & SHARE MOBILITY TEAM UP

Partnership to offer improved first/last-mile mobility | October 16, 2023

The Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) has partnered with SHARE Mobility to launch the ConnectWorks program for the Aerozone Alliance Region in Cleveland, Ohio. Through this program, as of October 16, SHARE Mobility will offer rides from GCRTA's Brookpark station to job locations within the Aerozone Alliance Region. Rides can be booked on-demand from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, for \$2.50 per trip. Companies can also sign up to provide rides as an employee benefit. ConnectWorks aims to help bridge the gap between the existing transit network and workplaces.
