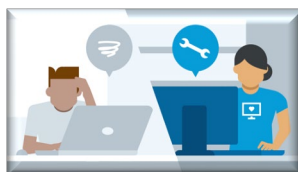
Committee Overview

The Vehicle-to-Everything (V2X) and Connected Transportation Standing Committee identifies legislative and regulatory barriers to the widespread deployment of V2X technologies, as opportunities associated with V2X technologies. This committee is tasked with advocating for policies which support the deployment of V2X technologies at scale, and addresses topics such as the development and deployment of connected, V2V, V2I, and V2P technologies and innovations.
